

## Economic, Social, Cultural and Environmental Rights in the peace agreement with the Farc-ep and its implementation in Colombia

Economic, social, cultural and environmental rights are necessary in societies that are consolidating peace processes. In Colombia's case, through the final agreement to end the conflict, measures were agreed to guarantee the rights to health, nutrition, food security, housing, water, education, and community projects for the victims. However, the implementation has been a slow process and the level of compliance has not been precise. Therefore, this article aims to describe the measures of the agreement that allow the materialization and implementation of DESCA in the post-agreement scenario in Colombia. To comply with the established objectives, a qualitative, empirical methodology was applied, supported by the deductive method. This allowed us to conclude that there are multiple difficulties in this process. The lack of implementation of the agreed measures and the social and territorial complexity has prevented due compliance, making it evident there is a lack of political desire for its materialization.
